

## Plant Ranch Nursery

### THINGS TO PLANT IN NOV & DEC

- 1. ANNUALS TO PLANT.** For both November and December plant delphinium, dianthus, foxglove (*digitalis*), larkspur, carnation (China doll), ornamental cabbage, ornamental kale, pansy, petunia, shasta daisy, snapdragon and violas. Be sure to trim off any dead blooms to promote new blooms.
- 2. VEGETABLES.** For November plant beets, broccoli, Brussels sprouts, cabbage, carrots, Chinese cabbage, collards, kale, kohlrabi, leek, mustard, onions, parsley, radish and spinach.
- 3. STRAWBERRIES.** November is a great time for planting strawberries. Plant Florida Belle, Sequoia, Dover Tioga, Florida 90, Tufts, Chandler and Sweet Charlie. Be sure to elevate rows 6" to be sure of good drainage. Plant 12" apart. Pine straw will help with weed problems and insects.
- 4. BULBS.** Aztec lily, crinum, calla, amaryllis, kaffir lily, African lily, pineapple lily, narcissus, hyacinth, elephant ears, daylily, shell ginger, spider lily, society garlic, spider lily and star of Bethlehem. In addition in December add tulip, voodoo lily, zephyr lily and watsonia. Be sure to chill your tulips and hyacinths. Refrigerate for 2 months. You can plant them in pots or in your landscape.
